All 3-4 year-old children are entitled to 15 hours per week (three hours per day) of free nursery childcare under the governments Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE) scheme. Working parents are entitled to an additional 15 funded hours, bringing the total entitlement to 30 hours per week (six hours per day). This additional entitlement is available to families where both parents (or the single parent in a single-parent family) work more than 16 hours a week.
